In **2025**, Cancer Support Community accomplished the following:

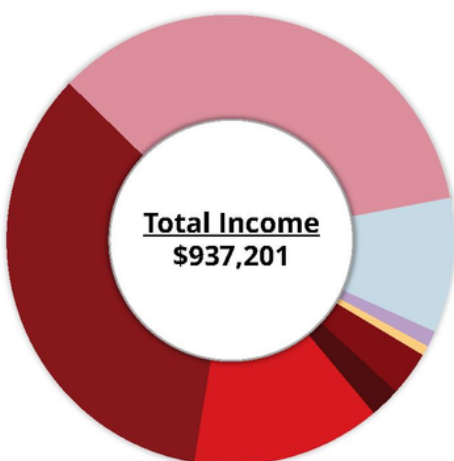
- **7,587** service hours provided
- **740** individuals served
- **5,849** total visits
- **23** community outreach events

Based on community assessment needs, **50% of programs are back in-person.** We also brought back **topic-focused** support groups and classes, provided a **wider variety of wellness classes**, and hosted **family-friendly social events.**

Surveyed participants in our programs and services experienced overwhelmingly positive outcomes:

- ▲ **97%** Would refer CSC to others
- ▲ **95%** Felt more connected
- ▲ **84%** Improved quality of life
